Recycled plastic from the ocean, glass, plywood, cardboard and cork make up some of the samples that appear on the wall of Brodie Neill's colourful East London studio. A master of materials, he uses all of the aforementioned to make both limited-edition furniture under his own name and mass produced pieces with production company Made in Ratio (also in the space). Works such as his Gyro table, made from fragments of recycled ocean plastic inland to achieve a terrazzo effect, woned visitors to the Australian Biennial and his Cowrie and Alpha chairs made it into 1000 Chairs published by Taschen. An honour indeed.
